POSITION SUMMARY:

Afterschool Youth Food Coordinator will contribute to the development of the program that addresses the issue of youth facing food insecurity. The Coordinator will follow a curriculum and play a key role in improving access to healthy food and building healthy eating habits in youth. The Coordinator will help to develop and implement new meal and snack planning with the participants and foster an environment where peers mentor peers. He/she will thrive in a fast-paced environment, and will continuously seek improvement of the program through different partnerships and collaborations.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Supervise children in groups and individually
- Work with children in a kitchen setting to promote independence, self-confidence, and comprehension using hands-on activities, both one-to-one and as a group
- Escort children to different locations within the building and on shopping excursions
- Help children to engage in social interaction with peers
- Help children to learn appropriate social behaviors and to be accountable for their decisions
- Create a safe and supportive space for participants
- Liaise with community resources and partners to improve health outcomes for youth
- Maintain program statics
- Establish an environment to sustain interest and promote positive interactions between participants
- Teach youth the importance of following rules and regulations and sharing a common space
- Work with youth to plan, carryout and serve meals/snacks to program participants and other youth
- Teach participants the fundamentals of budgeting, measuring, and shopping for ingredients
- Committed to uphold the organization's mission, values and standards
- Work safely, identify any health and safety concerns and report to management, and follow Mission Services workplace health and safety policies and procedures at all times.
- Adhere to a strict policy of confidentiality
- Other duties as required to ensure the continuation of service to clients

- Knowledge and understanding of Food Security and Nutrition
- Experience with Community/social services sector
- Ability to mediate and resolve conflict
